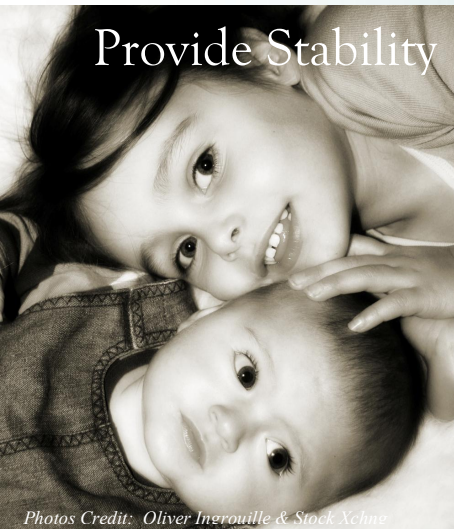


The immediate assistance the Maine Kids-Kin fund provides is often just enough to give what the family needs to get through a critical situation.

How this fund helps

The Maine Kids-Kin fund provides immediate assistance of a small amount of money to relative caregivers who need money to provide stability for their families.

The fund has helped with a variety of needs including:

- Put cars back on the road
- Kept the electricity on
- Paid for a babysitter when the grandparent is sick
- Bought furnishings for a new child.

Without these funds, the Grandfamilies we serve are at risk. This immediate assistance is often just enough to provide what the family needs to get through a critical situation.

When a relative makes a request, a staff person from F.A.C.T. talks to the family to help make sure that they are getting on-going resources to help avoid a crisis in the future.
